ITINERARY

MARCH 6 Sat - A “Get Acquainted” gathering at Justin’s Carriage Restaurant in Skippack Village for those of you participating in the transfer to Newark Airport and our overnight flight to Lisbon. (Cost of Transfer to be determined). We will board our Air Portugal non-stop flight to Lisbon. Dinner will be served en route

MARCH 7 Sun - Upon arrival in Lisbon and after going through customs we will proceed to the arrivals area and be met by a local guide. Our first stop will be for a light breakfast in the Belem District of Lisbon after which we will have a short visit at the Monstero Dos Jeronimos. We continue on to the beautiful resort area of Estoril, our home for the next five nights. Following check-in, the rest of the afternoon is free to relax and explore your surroundings. Dinner is served at your hotel this evening where you can get acquainted with your fellow traveling companions. Overnight Estoril (BD)

MARCH 8 Mon - This morning we depart the hotel and head to Portugal’s Capital City of Lisbon, set on the seven hills overlooking the Tagus River. The magnificent city of Lisbon has dramatic history linked to Africa, America an Asia. Lisbon’s reputation as the gateway to the world and city of culture is will known. Enjoy a city tour starting with a stop at the impressive fortress of Belem Tower, an exquisite example of the Manueline style it was built in 1515 as a fortress to defend the Harbour of Lisbon then continue to the Monument to the Discoveries where your guide will explain the history as outlined on the walkway. A short walk in the Moorish Alfama Quarter, the oldest surviving part of Lisbon and then the Baixa district a grid of elegant streets running from the Rossio to the palace. The remainder of the day is free for independent sightseeing and shopping. Consider going to the Castelo de Sao Jorge, the Moorish Castle high above the central Baixa area. Overnight Estoril, Evening free for dinner on your own. (BB)

MARCH 9 Tue - After breakfast, we’ll drive the short distance to Sintra, the favorite summer residence of the Kings of Portugal for six Centuries and the westernmost area of the Iberian Peninsula. Sintra is a popular tourist spot with its picturesque location at the foot of the small coastal mountains Sierra de Sintra that rise sharply above the city. The main attraction however is Sintra Castle, where you will be given a guided tour. Built in 1385 on the site of an 8th Cenntury Moorish castle, the whole site is now a UNESCO World Heritage Site (There are over 100 steps in the castle that you will ascend and descend during the tour) Next we will visit the scenic town of Cascais, one of Portugal’s most popular coastal resorts. The old town centre is the only place where there are still a few narrow alleys lined with pretty white houses. Enjoy a stroll amongst the many specialty shops filled with Portuguese handmade crafts. You will have the option to walk back to the hotel along the promenade or return with the coach. Dinner is on your own this evening at the hotel. Overnight Estoril. (BB)

MARCH 10 Wed - Today we travel to Portugal’s beautiful “Silver Coast”, a spectacular region filled with sleepy villages, rich vineyards and age-old castles. Our first stop is Fatima, the holy Marian Shrine and world famous pilgrimage site. Continue to Nazare, a beautiful coastal fishing village and then to Obidos, an enchanting medieval walled town, with tiny white washed houses brimming with flowers. Dinner included at the hotel this evening. Overnight Estoril (BB, BD)

MARCH 11 Thur - Your final day in Portugal will be leisurely spent in the nearby town of Azeitao. Here you will learn how the Portuguese make their famous “azulejos” (hand painted tiles) with a visit to a family-run shop. Next stop will be a visit to a centuries-old wine maker for a tour and a tasting of local wines. We head back to the Estoril coast later this afternoon for any last minute souvenir shopping. This evening enjoy a farewell dinner which will include a traditional dinner & folkloric music. Overnight Estoril (BB, BD)

MARCH 12 Fri– Depart this morning to the airport in Lisbon and our return flight arriving in Newark late afternoon. For those participating you will return to Skippack on the awaiting motor coach. (BB)
